

Agreement milestone

AN agreement to transport urea by rail from a new production plant in Collie to the Bunbury Port has been described as a "milestone step".

WestNet Rail and Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers signed a Heads of Agreement on Tuesday in a deal that has been described by both

companies as providing significant growth and revenue opportunities.

Perdaman is developing the urea manufacturing plant at Collie which is expected to produce two million tonnes of urea per annum which will be exported through the Port of Bunbury using the WestNet Rail network.
