\$3.5 billion urea plant promises bonanza for Collie

THE \$3.5 billion urea manufacturing plant at Collie's Shotts Industrial Park will generate more than \$850 million a year in export earnings for Western Australia, Perdaman Industries boss Vikas Rambal promised on Friday.

The first shipment is scheduled for 2013.

If all approvals are safely negotiated, construction is due to start early next year and the urea plant will generate about 1500 jobs during the three-year construction phase and 200 permanent jobs when plant operations begin.

"The plant has the capacity to produce two million tonnes of urea per annum and, while we are looking at the opportunity to supply local markets, the majority will be exported for global use;" Mr Rambal said at last Friday's official project launch in Collie. The Indian Government has contracted to buy two million tonnes a year.
