Collie Shire councillors voted on Tuesday night to modify Coolangatta Estate to make room for Bluewaters Power Station's three and four units.

Also, the contract to refurbish the overhead footbridge was finally awarded.

Kordametha administrator Brian McMaster reported a lot of interest in Griffin Coal and Bluewaters.

Finally, Perdaman Chemicals and Fertilisers signed an agreement with WestNet Rail to move urea to the Bunbury port.
